

Ryley School Graduation 2019

Graduation is an important milestone in a student's life. It is important that, as a graduand, you keep informed and keep your parents informed as the year progresses. Please use this as a guideline and pay attention to announcements and the school website for updated information.

- The graduation date will be determined by the school. **(May 24, 2019)**
- Students must be registered in at least half of their grade 12 credits at Ryley School.
- All school fees must be paid.
- Students will be eligible to participate in the graduation exercises provided they meet the criteria for graduation. Students will receive a Graduation Certificate from the school.
- All grade twelve students registered at Ryley School will be eligible to participate in the spring graduation exercises if they meet the following requirements.

Students Enrolled in a High School Diploma Program

In order to graduate and “walk the stage”, a student must meet the following requirements:

- achieve the minimum course credit requirements for a High School Diploma as established by Alberta Education
- achieved a minimum of 80 credits by the end of the first semester of the current year
- achieve a minimum grade of at least 50% in all non-diploma subjects
- any student registered in Work Experience must have completed 50% of the hours required by April 15th with timesheets handed in to the Work Experience Coordinator
- the student must be registered in the courses required to fulfill Alberta Education requirements for the diploma program and have a minimum of 50% in the course on April 15th.

Students Enrolled in a Certificate of High School Achievement Program

In order to graduate and “walk the stage”, a student must achieve the following requirements:

- meet the minimum course credit requirements for a Certificate of High School Achievement as established by Alberta Education.

Students Enrolled in a Certificate of School Completion

Students will receive their certificate of completion and “walk the stage” in their final year of programming.

Graduation List Procedures

1. Students must meet with administration by **Thursday, December 20, 2018** to verify that they are on track to meet the graduation requirements.
2. At the end of the first semester, any student whose eligibility to graduate is in doubt, based upon first semester results, will be notified as soon as those results are known. Parents will be informed in writing. Where possible, students will be encouraged to register in additional courses in order to permit participation in graduation ceremonies.
3. At the end of the first reporting period of the second semester, **any students whose progress is such that it appears he/she will not meet the requirements for graduation will be notified that he/she will not be eligible to participate.** Parents will be informed in writing.
4. The official graduation list will be posted on **Monday, April 15, 2019.**

Graduation and the School

The convocation ceremony and the celebration are both school sponsored events. Students are responsible to the school for their decorum. Behavior that detracts from the dignity of the celebration may result in the graduand losing the privilege of continuing with the day's activities.

Please Note: Safe Grad activities are **NOT** school sanctioned events.
