What is a Dual Credit Program?

Students are concurrently enrolled in a post secondary institution while at high school. Students earn credits towards their high school diploma AND the post secondary school. Their post-secondary tuition fees are paid by BRSD.

Dual credit helps students to:

- get a jump start on their post-secondary education while still in high school
- complete high school while engaging in meaningful curriculum
- transition to post-secondary studies or move into the world of work
- potentially complete post-secondary with less financial debt

Students interested in enrolling in any of the following courses should contact their school administrator to obtain application forms. Space in most programs is limited and filled on a first come, first served basis.
