Dear Ryley Rebels,

As we wrap up September, I want to take a moment to reflect on what has been a fantastic start to the school year. We've been lucky to enjoy some lovely warm weather, and our students have settled in beautifully!

We were thrilled to begin the year with free school supplies for every student, which helped everyone get organized and ready for success. With an enrollment of 104 students, we've also begun our numeracy and literacy assessments and have already started intervention programs to provide targeted support where needed.

This year, we are excited to introduce new option programming for grades 6-9, featuring courses in Agriculture, Design, and 3D Printing. These programs are designed to help students develop skills that will serve them well beyond high school.

Our Student Wellness Facilitator (SWF) and the Mental Health Capacity Building (MHCB) team continue to provide essential support for our students' well-being, creating a positive and caring school atmosphere. We also started offering our complimentary breakfast and lunch program right from the first day of school, ensuring all students are well-nourished and ready to learn. In addition, we've had two fantastic hot lunches, including a special lunch from a local food truck! Our School Council has been established, and I'm pleased to announce that Selena Hellekson is our Chair, Alysha Dietz is our Vice Chair, and Melody Gregory is our Secretary. Their leadership is a tremendous asset to our school community.

September has also been filled with exciting activities. Our whole-school outdoor learning

experience at the K3 Corn Maze was a big hit! We've kicked off our cross-country running and volleyball seasons, and students are already showing great enthusiasm and team spirit. We participated in the Terry Fox Run and Orange Shirt Day to honor the legacy of residential school survivors and promote the importance of reconciliation.

Another highlight this month is our new mascot contest! Students are designing, naming, and voting on a new school mascot, and the creativity has been inspiring. We can't wait to see the final result!

It's been a busy but wonderful start to the year, and we are looking forward to all that's ahead. Thank you for your continued support as we work together to make this year a success for every student!
