What supervisors and students NEED to bring:


- a “picnic” type bag lunch (we might be eating at a grassy area on the grounds)
- comfortable walking shoes (we want to see EVERYTHING!!)
- clothes appropriate for our changing weather
- water bottle or bottles
- sunscreen?/bug spray?/puffers/medications....
- a SMALL bag to carry things in? (carrying too much is exhausting, so choose wisely!)

You DO NOT HAVE TO BRING, but you ARE allowed:

- camera/phone for pictures
- money (to buy ice cream and/or to use in the gift shop if there is time)

If you bring a phone or money, **YOU must be responsible** for these items.

Schedule of Events:	Groups do not have to stay together, but we can follow the same path as we wander through the park enjoying all the amenities!
8:40 am	Leave Ryley School (Eat something on the bus. It's a long time till lunch!)
10:00 am	Arrive at the Bus Drop Off Zone Meet parent supervisors at the TICKET OFFICE Park opens at 10:00 am
10:10 am-10:30 am	Midway (83) We will put all our bags together. You can't take bags on the rides. The Midway gets much busier later in the day, so I like to try to get there quickly and get in line for at least one ride (maybe even more!) Have fun! Encourage our students to make good decisions about finding short lines. They can try the fun house and games. -The rides and games are free. -There is a food truck here if someone needs to buy something, but <u>no open ice cream or drinks on the train!</u> - Treasure Trove sells small toys and candy. They should shop now. It gets VERY busy later!

10:45 am	<p>1919 Baldwin Steam Train</p> <p>Board the train to the Fur Trade Fort so we can get off then work our way back to the entrance.</p> <p><i>The train leaves the station at 10:20, 10:55, 11:30, 12:05, 1:30, 2:05</i></p> <p>It is a 5 minute ride to the Fort. It stops for 10 minutes and then returns to the main station. There is usually a line up for the train, so we need to get there earlier than the departure time.</p>
11:00-11:20 am	<p>1846 Fur Trading Fort</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Explore the fur trade fort. -Be sure to go into the fur trade store and listen to the interpreters talk -Explore the Chief Factor's Big House 
11:30-11:50 am	<p>Indigenous Peoples Experience</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -The entrance is sort of around the back from where we will arrive (go to the left.) -It is a one way walk through experience. -It is beautiful and serene. Encourage thoughtful exploration. -There are often artisans selling goods at the exit.
12:00-12:30	<p>1885 Street</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - We will head back toward the fort and find the start of 1885 Street. -Go down 1885 Street exploring the oldest street at Fort Edmonton while you head to 1905 street. Go in the buildings. Look for 'interpreters' to talk to. -McDougall's General Store sells penny candy and other small shopping items
12:30-1:10	<p>LUNCH/1905 Street OR GYRO PARK which has a covered eating area and park</p> <p>Find a picnic table, bench or a piece of the boardwalk and sit for a break and have lunch. If we buy food then we can sit inside.</p> <p>Delicious French Fries:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Outside of Masonic Hall (56) is a good place to eat lunch and some students may want to buy a drink? <p>Buy an Ice Cream Cone? Try to buy a scoop from:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Sun Drug Store/Bill's Confectionery (73) <p>Explore the shops and buildings. The arcade is neat and so is the telephone building.</p>
1:15-1:40	<p>If we can, we will try to catch the streetcar to the Capitol Theatre (the Theatre is no longer a 4D experience, but a come and go experience of short documentaries.)</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Walk and explore the streets as you head back toward the entrance. Kids will want to go back to the Midway which is fine, but you must use the washroom BEFORE 1:50.</p>
1:45	Leave the Park/Use the Washrooms at Gift Shop area/Front Entry
2:00	Meet the bus back at the parking lot
3:20	Arrive at Ryley School
